Happy New Year to all our families and friends! During these challenging times we want to thank the teachers, families and students for all your support and work! We are excited to have students returning to classes on January 11th 2021.

All elementary students will return full time and high school students will continue the Hybrid model (attending every other day) until classes end for semester 1. All high school students will attend school every day beginning semester 2 (February 2nd).

We will continue on the schedule used in December. High School students start classes at 8:30 a.m. and elementary students start classes at 8:45 a.m. We have outside supervision from 8:15 – 8:45 a.m. We will not be offering prayer in January and February so all students will be dismissed at 3:00. We have outside supervision after school.

Thank you to our families for not entering our school building. In order to ensure the health and safety of our students we are limiting the people in our school building to staff and students only. If you would like to pay fees they can be etransfered online or dropped off in our mailbox at the front of the Hikma (Original) building. If you are dropping off cash in the mailbox, please drop it off during the school day so that it is not in the mailbox overnight or on the weekend.

A reminder to our families that the mandate from the Saskatchewan government is that you limit the number of people in your house or apartment to only the members of your home. Several students have mentioned to teachers about attending parties or going over to visit relatives, which is concerning considering the number of families in our community that have had or are impacted by Covid-19. Over 85% of our families are 5 people or more in their homes. The fines for not adhering to the mandate is now up to \$7500.00. We want our families to be safe, healthy and adhere to guidelines. Thank you for following the government mandate with your children.

Thank you to your commitment to your child/children's education. We are excited to have the students returning on January 11th and continue to hope and pray that our students, staff, families and community stay healthy and safe.
